- DATES OF OPERATION: June 10 August 23
- HOURS OF OPERATION: Monday Friday 7:00AM 5:45PM
- CHOOSE DAYS/WEEKS CAREFULLY: Save having to pay a \$10.00 per change fee later on by being prepared now.
- VARY SCHEDULE ACCORDING TO NEEDS: Register for the weeks and days each week that you want. Mix and match according to your family needs. Must register for a three day minimum each week.
- BE SURE YOUR CHILD'S 2023-24 GRADE IS CORRECT IN YOUR PORTAL: Only children currently enrolled in the 23-24 school year, and are in K3 -7th grade are eligible to enroll with Camp M.
- SCHEDULE CHANGES: \$10.00 PER WEEKLY CHANGE After your original registration is received and processed, all schedule changes (adds and drops) are assessed a \$10.00 fee. Schedule adds can be requested throughout the summer, however April 1, 2024 is the deadline for all drops and cancellations.
- **REGISTRATION FEE (\$38/\$18 add. children)** must be paid to complete your registration. Credit Card, Ach, and E-Check are accepted, however save the credit card processing fee by using ACH or electronic check.
- WAIT LIST- All registration requests go to the wait list until they are individually approved. Approvals are determined by space and available staff.
- PLEASE BE PATIENT: It may take some time to complete all the state required information when registering. For best results, use a Chrome Browser and complete registrations on a computer.



CAMP M ADDITIONAL FIELD TRIP INFORMATION

Please take note of information important to field trips:

- All children who are registered the day a field trip occurs are expected to participate with the group.
- \$17.00 FIELD TRIP CHARGE Field Trip days have a \$17.00 fee added to them. Trips denoted with a * have an increased fee. See those trips below. Field Trip fees are billed after the trip occurs.
- No alternative care is provided, no refunds are given.
- All children registered the day of a planned trip are charged tuition for the day, and any field trip fees, regardless of attendance.
- Children are required to ride the bus with their group both to and from the trip.
- Dropping off or picking up from a field trip is not allowed.
- Field trips are carefully selected to offer the most enriching and exciting experiences.
- Camp M averages a one to five staff/child ratio on field trips.
- Campers are always safely transported in a school bus or coach bus.
- Field trips may be adjusted with little notice to ensure both the safety of the children and a fun, exciting day!

*SPECIAL FIELD TRIP FEES - The following Special Trips have a fee higher than \$17.00:

- Late Night Party \$30.00
- Brewers Game \$28.00
- Bay Beach \$32.00

All Field Trip fees will be billed if your child is registered on the day these trips occur regardless of attendance.

REGISTRATION FEES:

\$38.00 per child/\$18.00 each additional child. This fee is paid when completing the online registration process. The fee covers the administrative costs of processing the application plus two summer camp t-shirts. It is non-refundable.

SUNSCREEN FEE:

\$12.00 per child. Milestones provides sunscreen and mosquito repellant for all children participating in its programs. This fee covers the costs.
